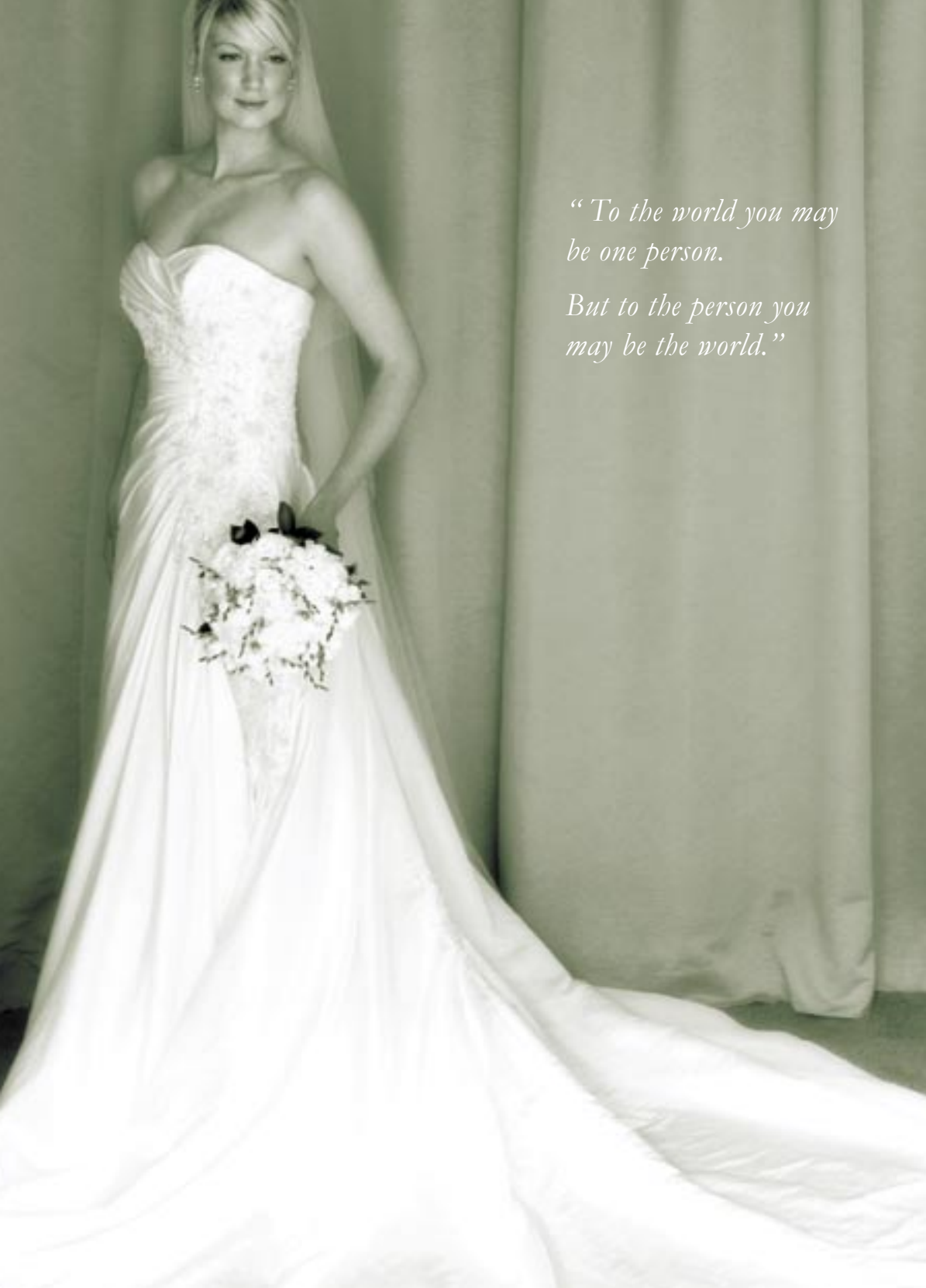

STEEPED IN HISTORY

The Buccleuch Arms Hotel stands beside the village green in St Boswells, bordering the main road from Jedburgh to Edinburgh. The village was previously known as “Lessudden” (from Lis-Edwin, the Court of Edwin) and was a very important stronghold, having 16 bastle-houses which were destroyed by the invading forces of Henry VIII in 1545.

The Hotel takes its name from the family who built it. The 5th Duke of Buccleuch was a boy of 13 when he inherited his title in 1819 after his father died unexpectedly in Lisbon. He married the daughter of the Marquess of Bath in 1829 and they lived at Dalkeith House. The Duke ran a pack of hounds at Dalkeith, but he also had a lodge at Eildon near Melrose and decided to build kennels for his hunt nearby. He chose ground near to the village green which bordered the road to Edinburgh and a fine kennels was erected in 1836. The Buccleuch Arms Inn was built alongside “to accommodate the aristocracy of fox-hunting proclivities”.

LOCATION

The hotel is conveniently set in the heart of the Scottish Borders, in the pretty village of St. Boswells. Even though we are set in a rural location, we are just over an hour’s drive from Edinburgh, Carlisle and Newcastle airports, 1 hour from Berwick-upon-Tweed and approximately 3 hours from the ferry terminal at Stranraer.

The Salmon Room is of a beautiful and contemporary design and seats up to 100 guests at round tables for a served or buffet style meal or carvery. The Salmon Room has its own private bar and wash rooms and a large wooden dance floor for dancing the night away. Location

Travel directions from the South (A68)

Travelling North from Newcastle, we are 8 miles North of Jedburgh on the A68. Approach St Boswells, with the cricket pitch to your left, the entrance to the car park is 1st left.

Travel directions from the South (A7)

Travelling from Carlisle / M6 / M74 direction approaching Selkirk on the A7, with Selkirk Golf Club on the right, take 1st right onto the A699. Continue until reaching St Boswells, turn left onto A68 with cricket pitch on your left - the car park is to your left.

From the North (A68)

Travelling South on A68 from Edinburgh, pass through Lauder and Earlston. Enter St Boswells - we are on the right, next to cricket pitch. Car parking at either side.
